Director's report: youth baseball, blast ball and softball are scheduled, umpires are being hired.

Wayne Park: women's bathroom had some vandalism

Lawson's baseball Field 3 and 4 scoreboard temporary fix with PVC, will be replaced with permanent metal tubing after baseball season is done.

Budget discussion: investigating leasing lawn mowers and getting quotes, all mowers are in use and in good repair.

New Business: Lawson Park Dog Park Verizon Wireless would like to place a communications tower at Lawson: lease payments would help pay for building the dog park. This would be a source of revenue for the Parks dept for an indefinite amount of time.
