Mr. Gegg reported that the DHM for our area has been extended through May 31st. Last day for online learning in the 13th and all work will be accepted with no loss of credit until May 19th. The lunch program is serving free lunches through June 26th to any child up to age 18 due to waivers put in place by the USDA. We are preparing to possibly add technology so that lower elementary id more prepared if there is another DHM in the late fall.
